**WordServe needs your help!**



**Whether you can serve once a month, every other week, every week, or some combination of Sundays, we can use your help!** (In no way will you be expected to make an every week commitment or permanently leave Grace Fellowship.) WordServe needs all kind of people to do all kinds of things. No matter your interest or ability, there is a place for you. The small job you do may be just the thing God uses to draw someone to WordServe and a transform a life!

**Here's how you can join this awesome adventure:**

1. Read the front and back of this insert to see the wide array of different serving opportunities, and pick out the role(s) where you would like to serve. Note the ministry area where your role is (e.g., children's, equipment, etc.).
2. Immediately following this worship service, go to the WordServe table on the porch of the worship center.
3. Look for the sign that corresponds to the ministry area where you want to serve. There will be a clipboard on the table for you to sign up.
4. Please PRINT your name, email address, phone number, the role where you'd like to serve, and the frequency you are willing to serve (e.g., once a month, every other week, etc.).
5. If you have any questions, ask one of the WordServe team at the tables on the porch. WordServe will follow up with you to confirm your service role and frequency.

### **Children's Ministry**

*(Numbers in parentheses indicate number of servants needed assuming each servant serves once per month.)*

**Check In/Check Out Volunteer**—Greet parents and children; help facilitate child registration and class assignment. (16 servants needed)

**Large Group Elementary Teacher**—Using curriculum provided, lead a large group lesson for elementary students in grades K-5. (4 servants needed)

**Large Group Worship Leader**—Energetically lead elementary students in worship songs and motions. (4 servants needed)

**Nursery Assistant**—Assist paid childcare workers and nursery workers with children birth-24 months. (12 servants needed)

**Preschool Teacher**—Teach preschoolers Bible stories, play with children, make crafts, and sing songs. (12 servants needed)

**K-2nd Grade Small Group Leader**—Greet/play with children upon arrival, participate with them in large group, and lead relational activities after large group. (12 servants needed)

**3rd-5th Grade Small Group Leader**—Greet/play with children upon arrival, participate with them in large group, and lead relational activities after large group. (12 servants needed)

**Roaming Helper**— Move from class to class and help where needed. (8 servants needed)

**Technology Helper**—Help set up sound/video equipment. Run PowerPoints/DVDs for elementary large group. (4 servants needed)

## Equipment Team

*(Numbers in parentheses indicate number of servants needed assuming each servant serves once per month.)*

**Trailer Hauling/Road Signs**—Bring WordServe trailer from storage facility. Put up road signs. Pick up signs and return trailer to storage facility after worship service (approximately 7:00 a.m.). (4 servants with pick up truck and 16 other servants needed)

**Building Preparation**—Clean and prepare bathrooms and meeting spaces as needed (approximately 7:15 a.m.). (8 servants needed)

**Equipment Set Up**—Unload trailer and set up all equipment for sound system, nursery, children's ministry, main worship area, and hospitality area before worship service (approximately 7:15 a.m.). (36 servants needed)

**Equipment Tear Down**—Take down and pack all equipment for sound system, nursery, children's ministry, main worship area, and hospitality area following worship service (approximately 11:00 a.m.). (36 servants needed)

## Hospitality Team

*(Numbers in parentheses indicate number of servants needed assuming each servant serves once per month.)*

**Greeter/Usher**—Warmly greet people as they arrive, help people feel welcome, serve worship attendees. (24 servants needed)

**Parking Lot Attendants**—Direct traffic and coordinate parking. Warmly greet people as they arrive. (12 servants needed)

**Refreshment Station**—Set up refreshment table, maintain table during service, serve guests as they come to table, and clean up. (8 servants needed)

**Refreshment Supply Person**—Receive list of needed supplies from hospitality coordinator, purchase needed supplies (with WordServe funds), and deliver them on Sunday morning. (4 servants needed)

**Welcome/Information Table**—Working alongside a WordServe team member, welcome guests and answer questions as needed. (4 servants needed)

**Follow-up/Connection**—Help follow-up with Sunday morning guests. Make calls or write notes as needed. (8 servants needed)

## Worship Team

*(Numbers in parentheses indicate number of servants needed assuming each servant serves once per month.)*

**Sound Tech. Help**—Assist sound technician prior to, during, and after worship service. (8 servants needed)

**Computer/Video Projection**—Create and/or run projection for worship services. (8 servants needed)

**Play an Instrument in Worship Band**—Band members will be chosen as needed. Please indicate interest in playing at the WordServe table.

**Sing with Worship Band**—Singers will be chosen as needed. Please indicate interest in singing at the WordServe table.

## Prayer Team

*(Numbers in parentheses indicate number of servants needed assuming each servant serves once per month.)*

**Prayer Group Before Service**—Gather at 9:15 to pray for all aspects of the service. (20 servants needed)

**Prayer During Service**—Pray for movement of the Holy Spirit during worship services. (20 servants needed)

**Altar Team**—Pray with people at altar during worship service. (20 servants needed)

**Prayer Administrative Help**—Help with administrative needs in prayer ministry. (4 servants needed)
