

My Beautifully Flawed Journey – The Book of Numbers is a book in the Bible that describes the journey of the Jewish people from Mt. Sinai to the edge of the Promised Land to wandering in the wilderness and back to the edge of the Promised Land again. The book begins with a census (Chapters 1-4) and ends with a census (Chapter 26); thus, the book title "Numbers."

Two Lessons to Learn From Moses' Mistake (Numbers 20)

1. Lesson #1: Do whatever it takes to get your

- What did Moses do that was wrong?
 - He raged at the people (v.10)
 - He took credit for a miracle that only God could give (v.10)
 - He disobeyed God by striking the rock instead of speaking to the rock (vv.8,11)
 - He did not believe God nor uphold God's holiness (v.12)
- What led to Moses' disobedient rage?
 - Repeated complaints and disrespect from the people (vv.2-5). This is their 11th time of grumbling and complaining.

2. Lesson #2: Allow a fuller understanding of _____ to drive you to faith dependence

on Jesus

- At first blush, God's "no Promised Land for you" punishment of Moses seems like an exaggerated response to the trivial difference between "speaking to" and "striking" the rock to get a miracle for water. But that perspective does not understand the holiness of God. Verse 12 is key!
- Tony Evans: "The holiness of God is His intrinsic and transcendent purity, the standard of righteousness to which the whole universe must conform. God does not conform to any standard created by others. He is the standard."
- Holiness is a really, really big deal!!!! The consequence for not upholding holiness is death – not getting to enter the Promised Land (Heaven, the abundant life).
- Romans 3:23; 6:23 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. (And) the wages of sin is death.
- Moses and Joshua as types. Moses is a picture of the OT Law (works; self-effort). Moses cannot take you into the Promised Land (heaven, the abundant life). Joshua is a picture of NT grace (free gift that is received). Joshua's name means "Yahweh is salvation." Jesus' name is "Joshua" (in Greek). Joshua (Jesus) can take you into the Promised Land (heaven, the abundant life).
- Application #4 Jesus, I place my faith and trust in You to save me from my sins through Your death and resurrection and to take me into Your Promised Land for me both in this life and the next.

- Rudolf Otto defines God's holiness as mysterium tremendum ("awful mystery"). In other words, you cannot put God in a box. He is full of holy mystery. God performs TONS of miracles, but He rarely performs a miracle in the same manner twice. God is not a formula or a magical ritual – He is an awesome, holy mystery!

Four "Say YES" Prayers for You and Grace Fellowship in Fall 2022

Say YES to HEALING - Lord, heal us from the consequences of our own sin and others' sins against us. Heal us from unhealthy behaviors, talk, and agendas. (Jer. 17:14) Interrupt the status quo in each of us that we may be whole and holy. (John 3:3; 6:53)

Ask the Lord specifically to heal _____ in you, your marriage, your family, and the church; and any next steps for you to heal.

Say YES to HOLINESS - Lord, make us holy as You are holy. (1 Peter 1:16) Wash us with Your Word and enable us to live in holiness (1 Tim. 2:21) as a radiant, spotless, without wrinkle Bride. (Eph. 5;26-27) Give us clean hands and an upright heart.

Invite the Holy Spirit to search you and reveal any places to cleanse. Say I'm sorry to God. Invite Christ's holiness upon your life, your family, and the church.

Say YES to the HARVEST – Jesus, You are saying to us, "the harvest is ready" (John 4:35) for the reaping. Give us the obedience of Peter to do as You did and become fishers of people (John 5:10) so the world will come to know You! (John 3:16, Rev. 5:19) Please lead each of us to share ourselves in serving, giving, and praying. (Romans 12:1)

Ask God where He wants you to "let down your net" and then say yes to serving; joining a class or group; or going on a mission trip. Ask Him about your part in giving and praying toward those He longs to know Him.

Say YES to the HOME - Father, our prayer is to choose to live as Your household (Eph. 2:19) rooted in Christ (Eph 2:20). Fill this "house" with Your Spirit (Eph 2:22) so that we may grow into a spiritual family as God's own children. (1 John 3:2) Raise up "mothers and fathers" who will nurture Your people in love—messy love—across all ages to truly know You and make You know. (1 Cor. 4:15)
