

Statistics on Porn

- According to a poll by ChristiaNet, 50% of all Christian men and 20% of all Christian women are addicted to pornography. (Marketwire.com, 2006)
- According to AVN News, 55% of all movie rentals in hotels are porn movies. (State of the Adult Industry, 2005)
- According to a study by the University of Alberta, 1/3 of all 13 year old boys have viewed pornography. (thegatewayonline.ca, 2007)
- According to MSNBC, 60% of all website visits are sexual in nature (NSNBC Survey, 2000)
- The #1 search term used at search engine sites is the word "sex" (Alexa Research).
- According to the Internet Filter Review, the annual revenues of the sex and porn industry in the United States is \$13.3 billion – that's more revenue than the NFL, the NBA, and Major League Baseball combined. And that's just in the United States. Worldwide sex industry annual sales are \$97 billion. To put that in perspective, Microsoft's annual sales worldwide are only \$45 billion.
- According to CBS, 50% of all people who stay in a hotel rent a pornographic movie... accounting for 70% of hotel's in-room profits. One hotel owner said, "I have to offer porn movies at my hotel. I have no choice. Our guests demand it!" (2003)
