

Biblical Worldview—How to Think Like a Christian in a World that Doesn't

Summary: A six-week interactive class that will help solidify your understanding of the Biblical worldview, why it is superior to all other options and how it provides the foundation for the best answers to the current cultural issues.

Goal: Students will better understand and more effectively share the truth and goodness of the Biblical worldview in interactions with their family, friends, disciples and co-workers.

Outline of the 6 sessions:

- 1: Worldview: What is it, why does it matter and what are the options
- 2: Biblical Worldview: Why it provides the best answers to the 5 worldview questions
- 3: Competing Western Worldviews: Naturalism, Post Modernism and MTD
- 4: Competing Global Worldviews: Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism and New Age
- 5: Applying Worldview Thinking to Current Issues Part 1
- 6: Applying Worldview Thinking to Current Issues Part 2

Details: Everyone has a worldview, which in turn drives our beliefs, values and behaviors. A worldview is what you believe to be true about five key areas: origin, meaning, morality, identity and destiny. Our worldview, based on the Bible, is both true and good. However, the world has many alternatives that offer different answers to the worldview questions and different solutions to the problems we are facing. This class will help you solidify your Biblical worldview and help you better understand how other people think. This will facilitate your interactions with non-Christians and allow you to recognize and refute the lies that our culture is promoting.

Logistics: The 2025 class will begin on Sunday April 27th from 4 to 6 pm, meeting next door at the Bible Seminary in room 270. Each session will include teaching, full-class interactions and small group working sessions. There is no homework required.
