Perfecto	<i>tay-mim</i> = sin defecto; intachable; irreprochable
Seguro	<i>ay-mon</i> = fiel, seguro, establecido
Recto	<i>yay-sar</i> = recto, nivelado, recto
Puro	<i>bar</i> = puro, radiante, escogido, especial
Limpio	<i>tay-hor</i> = limpio, sin impurezas, impecable
Eterno	<i>ay-mad had</i> = perdurable para siempre; eterno, permanente
Verdad	<i>emet</i> = veraz, certero, honesto, lleno de integridad, confiable, digno de confianza
Justo	<i>say-da-q ya-had</i> = completamente justo, el estándar de Dios
Deseable	<i>hay-mad</i> = deleitable, altamente deseable, agradable, selecto
dulce	<i>may-toq</i> = dulce, de sabor agradable

Pregunta de Aplicación: ¿Cuál de estas experiencias de Dios a través de Su Palabra necesitas en tu vida ahora mismo? (vv.7-11)

- REAVIVAMIENTO:** Señor, por favor, aviva mi alma a través de Tu Palabra (v.7a).
- SABIDURÍA:** Señor, por favor, dame sabiduría a través de Tu Palabra (v.7b).
- GOZO:** Señor, por favor, da gozo a mi corazón a través de Tu Palabra (v.8a).
- LUZ:** Señor, por favor, ilumina mi camino a través de Tu Palabra (**v.8b**).
- SUSTENTO ESPIRITUAL:** Señor, por favor, alimenta mi alma a través de Tu Palabra (v.10).
- ADMONICIÓN:** Señor, por favor, avísame a través de Tu Palabra dónde necesito amonestación (v.11a).
- VALENTÍA ESPIRITUAL:** Señor, por favor, dame la obediencia que lleva a la recompensa (v.11b).

En términos prácticos, ¿cómo accedemos a estas experiencias de Dios inducidas por la Palabra? (vv.10-14).

1. _____ Su Palabra (v. 10)

- Tanto el oro como la miel representan el deseo. Como humanos, sabemos lo que es desear dinero (oro) y lo que es desear comida sabrosa (miel). ¡El Salmo 19 dice que la Palabra de Dios es más deseable que ambos!
- hay-mad = codiciar, lujuriar, desear
- Esta es la misma palabra que se usa en los Diez Mandamientos para decir: «No codiciarás» (Éxodo 20:17) y que se usa en Proverbios 6:25 para exhortarnos a no codiciar a una prostituta.
- Pero el Salmo 19 dice que hay una cosa que DEBEMOS codiciar y desear: la Palabra de Dios.
- Si quieres experimentar a Dios, ¡entonces desea su Palabra más que el dinero, el oro, el pastel de queso con chocolate Godiva o la miel! Cuanto más “comes” la Palabra de Dios, más la deseas.
- Aplicación #1: Para aumentar mi deseo por la Palabra de Dios, voy a...
 - Orar por un mayor deseo por la Palabra de Dios: “¡Señor, dame más papilas gustativas en mi corazón para tu Palabra!”
 - ¡Comer” la Palabra de Dios meditando frecuentemente en las asombrosas promesas que Dios me ha dado en Su Palabra!
 - ¡Temblar ante la Palabra de Dios!
- **Isaías 66:2:** *A este miraré: al que es humilde y contrito de espíritu, y que tiembla ante mi Palabra.*

2. _____ Su Palabra (v.10)

- La analogía de la miel es una analogía con la comida. En las Escrituras se nos exhorta repetidamente a “comer” la Palabra de Dios (Salmo 119:103; Jeremías 15:16; Ezequiel 2:8-3:3; Mateo 4:4; Apocalipsis 10:9-10).
- Cómo comer la Palabra de Dios:
 - (1) Como la miel (Salmo 19:10): deleitándose con su sabor.
 - (2) Como un bebé que bebe leche (1 Pedro 2:2): como

Ten Characteristics of God’s Word (vv.7-11)

perfect	<i>tay-mim</i> = without defect; unblemished; blameless
sure	<i>ay-mon</i> = faithful, sure, established
right	<i>yay-sar</i> = straight, level, upright
pure	<i>bar</i> = pure, radiant, chosen, special
clean	<i>tay-hor</i> = clean, no impurities, flawless
eternal	<i>ay-mad had</i> = enduring forever; eternal, standing forever
true	<i>emet</i> = true, certain, honest, full of integrity, reliable, trustworthy
righteous	<i>say-daq ya-had</i> = altogether righteous, God’s standard
desirable	<i>hay-mad</i> = delightful, highly desirable, pleasing, choice
sweet	<i>may-toq</i> = sweet, pleasant taste

Application Question – Which of these experiences of God through His Word do you need in your life right now? (vv.7-11)

- REVIVING** – Lord, please revive my soul through Your Word (v.7a)
- WISDOM** – Lord, please give me wisdom through Your Word (v.7b)
- JOY** – Lord, please give my heart joy through Your Word (v.8a)
- LIGHT** – Lord, please illuminate my path through Your Word (v.8b)
- SPIRITUAL SUSTENANCE** – Lord, please feed my soul thru Your Word (v.10)
- ADMONITION** – Lord, please warn me through Your Word where I need admonition (v.11a)
- SPIRITUAL GRIT** – Lord, please give me the obedience that leads to reward (v.11b)

Practically Speaking, HOW Do We Tap into These Word-Induced Experiences of God? (vv.10-14)

1. _____ **His Word (v.10)**

- Gold and honey are both pictures of desire. As humans, we know what it is to desire money (gold) and what it is to desire great tasting food (honey). Psalm 19 says that God's Word is more desirable than both of those!!!
- *hay-mad* = covet, lust, desire
- This is the same word used in the Ten Commandments to say, "Thou shall not covet" (Exodus 20:17) and used in Proverbs 6:25 to exhort us not to lust after a prostitute.
- But Psalm 19 says there is one thing that we are SUPPOSED TO covet and lust after (desire) – namely, God's Word.
- If you want to experience God, then desire His Word more than money, gold, Godiva chocolate cheesecake, or honey!!!
- The more you "eat" God's Word, the more you desire God's Word.
- **Application #1** – To increase my desire for God's Word, I am going to...
 - Pray for an increased desire for God's Word: "Lord, give me increased tastebuds on my heart for Your Word!"
 - "Eat" God's Word frequently meditating on God's staggering promises to me in His Word!
 - Tremble at God's Word!
- **Isaiah 66:2** – *This is the one to whom I will look: he who is humble and contrite in spirit and trembles at My Word.*

2. _____ **His Word (v.10)**

- The honey analogy is an eating analogy. Multiple times in Scripture we are exhorted to "eat" God's Word (Psalm 119:103; Jeremiah 15:16; Ezekiel 2:8-3:3; Matthew 4:4; Revelation 10:9-10).
- How to eat God's Word:
 - (1) Like honey (Psalm 19:10) – taking delight in its taste
 - (2) Like a baby drinking milk (1 Peter 2:2) – as our very sustenance
 - (3) Like steak (Hebrews 5:11-14) – moving toward substance and lasting protein.

- Train and discipline my children (Ephesians 6:4; Proverbs 3:11-12; 19:18; 22:6; 23:13-14; 29:15,17)
- Handle my money wisely by giving, saving, budgeting (1 Corinth 16:2; 2 Corinth 9:6-11; Matt 6:19-21; Prov 3:9-10; 6:1-11; 11:15; 13:11; 14:21,31; 15:16-17; 16:8,16; 17:1; 21:20; 22:9; 23:4-5; 28:6,8,11,22,27; Malachi 3:7-10)
- Serve in Christ's church (1 Peter 4:8-11)

4. _____ **His Word** (vv.12-14)

- The psalm moves from discussing God's Word to PRAYING God's Word back to Him. The most powerful prayers are praying Scripture.
- Beth Moore: "I have never discovered a more powerful way to demolish strongholds in my life than praying Scripture."
- David asks God to... (1) declare me right with God; (2) give me victory over sin; and (3) give me words that are pleasing to God.
- Application #4 – I choose to pray God's Word for...
