Fiestas designadas por Dios para su pueblo

Fiestas	Propósito
Sábado (23:1-3)	Día sagrado de descanso que celebra el descanso de Dios en la creación
Pascua y Panes sin levadura (23:4-8)	Celebración de la liberación de Dios de la esclavitud en Egipto
Primicias (23:9-14)	Dedicación a Dios de la primera porción de la cosecha temprana (cebada)
Semanas de Pentecostés (23:15-22)	Alabanza a Dios por la cosecha y la dedicación de la primera porción de las cosechas posteriores 50 días después de las primicias
Trompetas (23:23-25)	Celebración del comienzo del año nuevo civil
Día de la Expiación (23:26-32)	Expiación por los pecados de toda la nación

Tiendas (tabernáculos) (23:33-44)	Celebración de la liberación de Egipto y la provisión del Señor en el desierto
Año del Jubileo (25:8-55)	No se cosecha ni siembra y toda la tierra se devuelve al propietario original y los esclavos a sus familias.

¿Por qué celebrar estas fiestas?

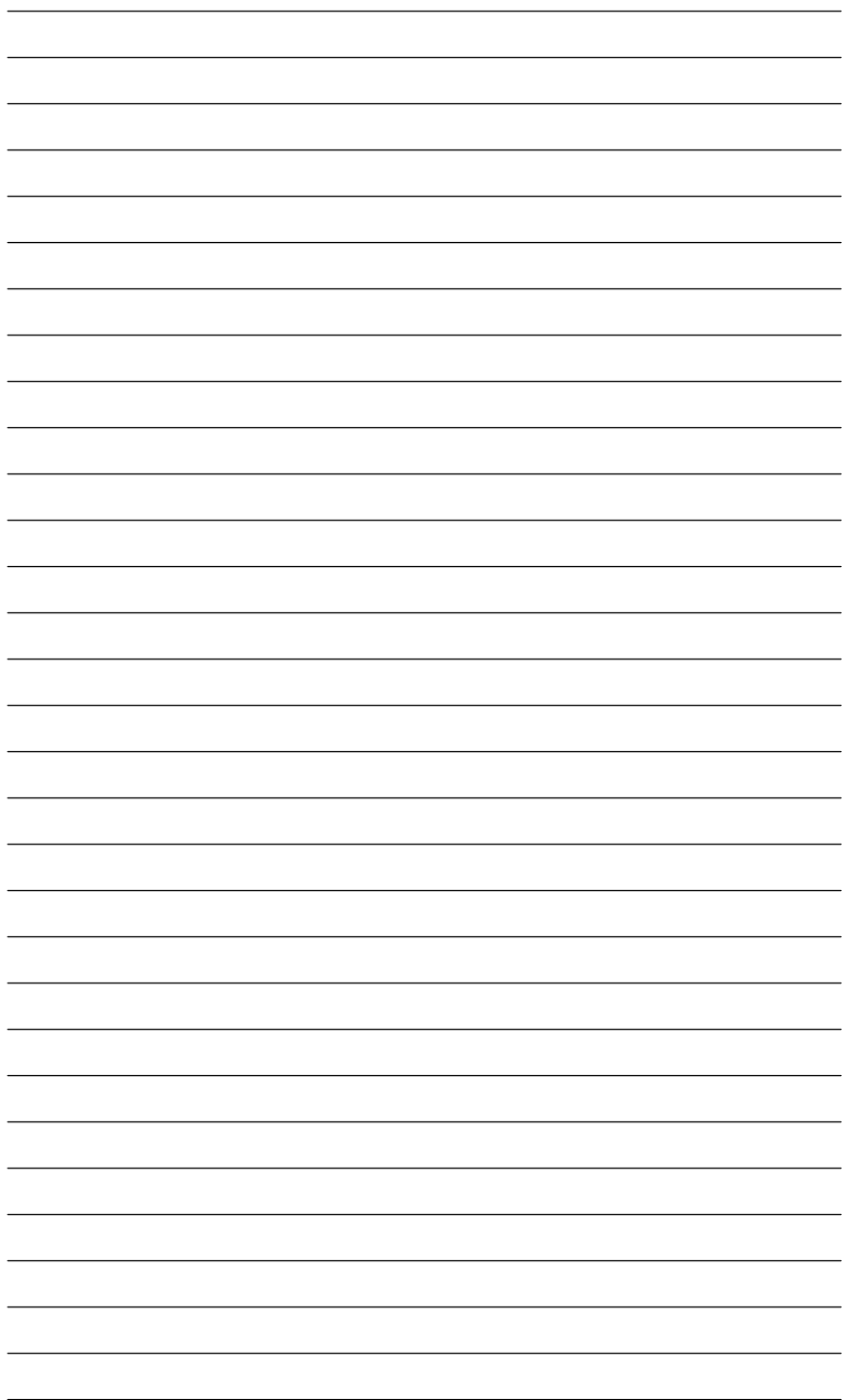
- Recordaron al pueblo la liberación de Dios.

- Restauraron la comunión con Dios.
- Renovaron el compromiso de Israel con Dios y la confianza en su guía y protección.

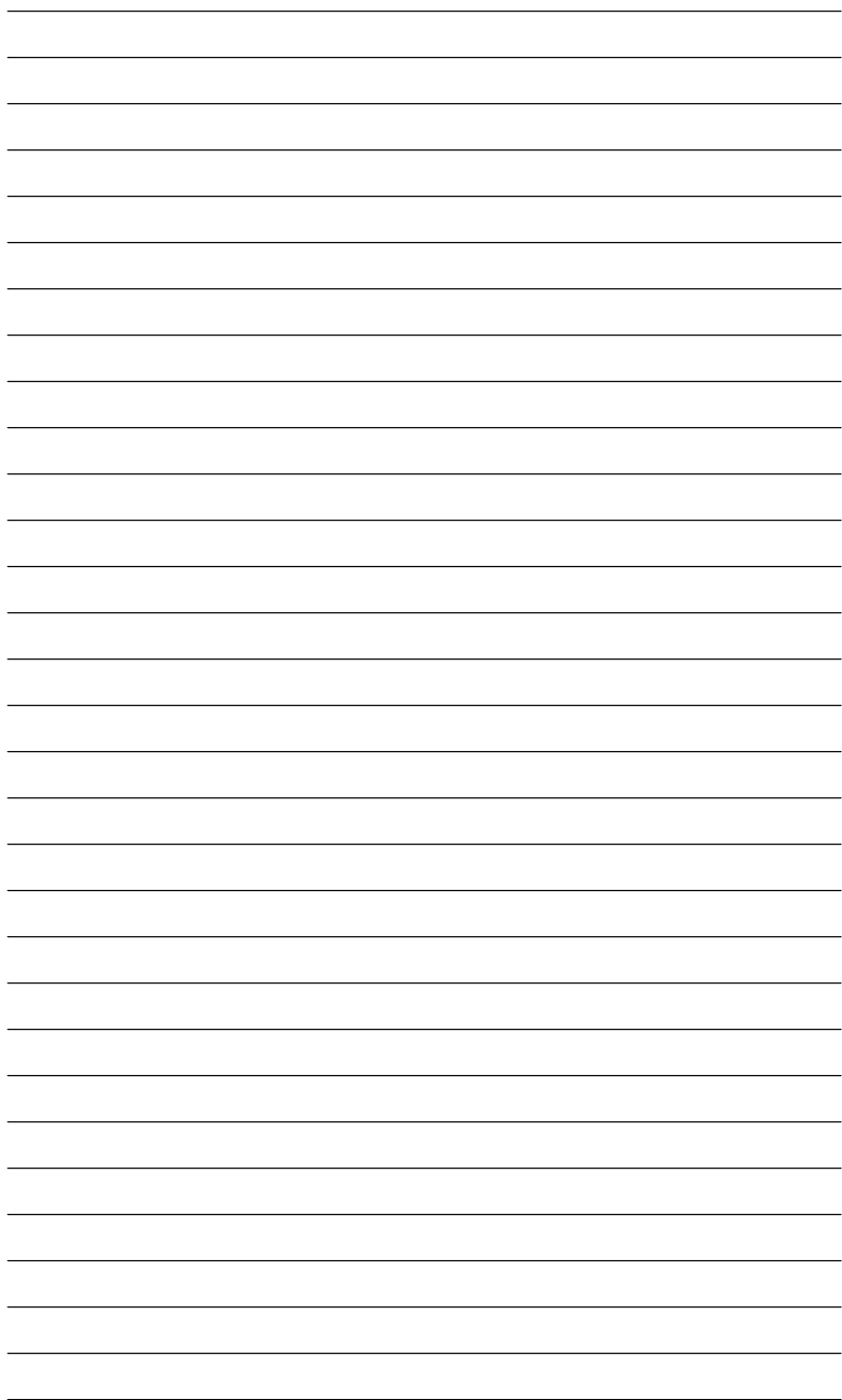

Festivals Appointed By God For His People

<i>Festival</i>	<i>Purpose</i>
Sabbath (23:1-3)	A Holy day of rest celebrating God's rest at creation
Passover and Unleavened bread (23:4-8)	Celebrating Gods deliverance from slavery in Egypt
First Fruits (23:9-14)	Dedicating to God the first portion of the earliest crop (barley)
Weeks Pentecost) (23:15-22)	Praising God for the harvest and dedication of the first portion of the later crops 50 days after first fruits
Trumpets (23:23-25)	Celebrating the beginning of the civil new year
Day of Atonement (23:26-32)	Atonement for the sins of the entire nation
Booths (tabernacles) (23:33-44)	Celebrating the deliverance from Egypt and the provision of the Lord while in the wilderness
Year of Jubilee (25:8-55)	No reaping or sowing and all land is returned to original owner and slaves to their families

Why Celebrate these feasts

- They reminded the people of Gods deliverance
- They reminded the people they were leaving the old life behind and entering a new way of living
- They reminded the people that God was their provider
- They reminded the people to show joy over and be thankful for the harvest
- They restored fellowship with God
- They renewed Israels commitment to God and to trust in His guidance and protection

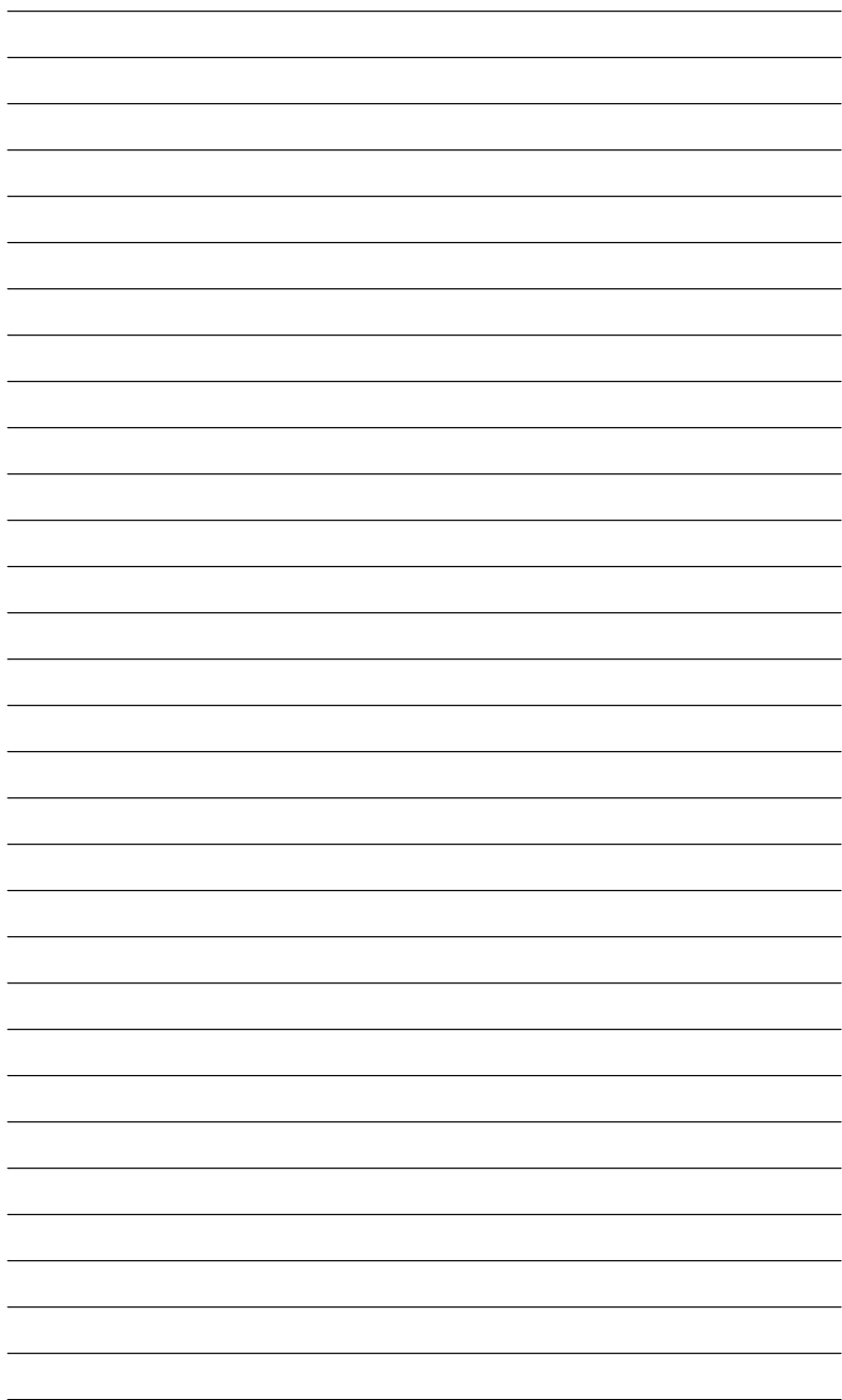

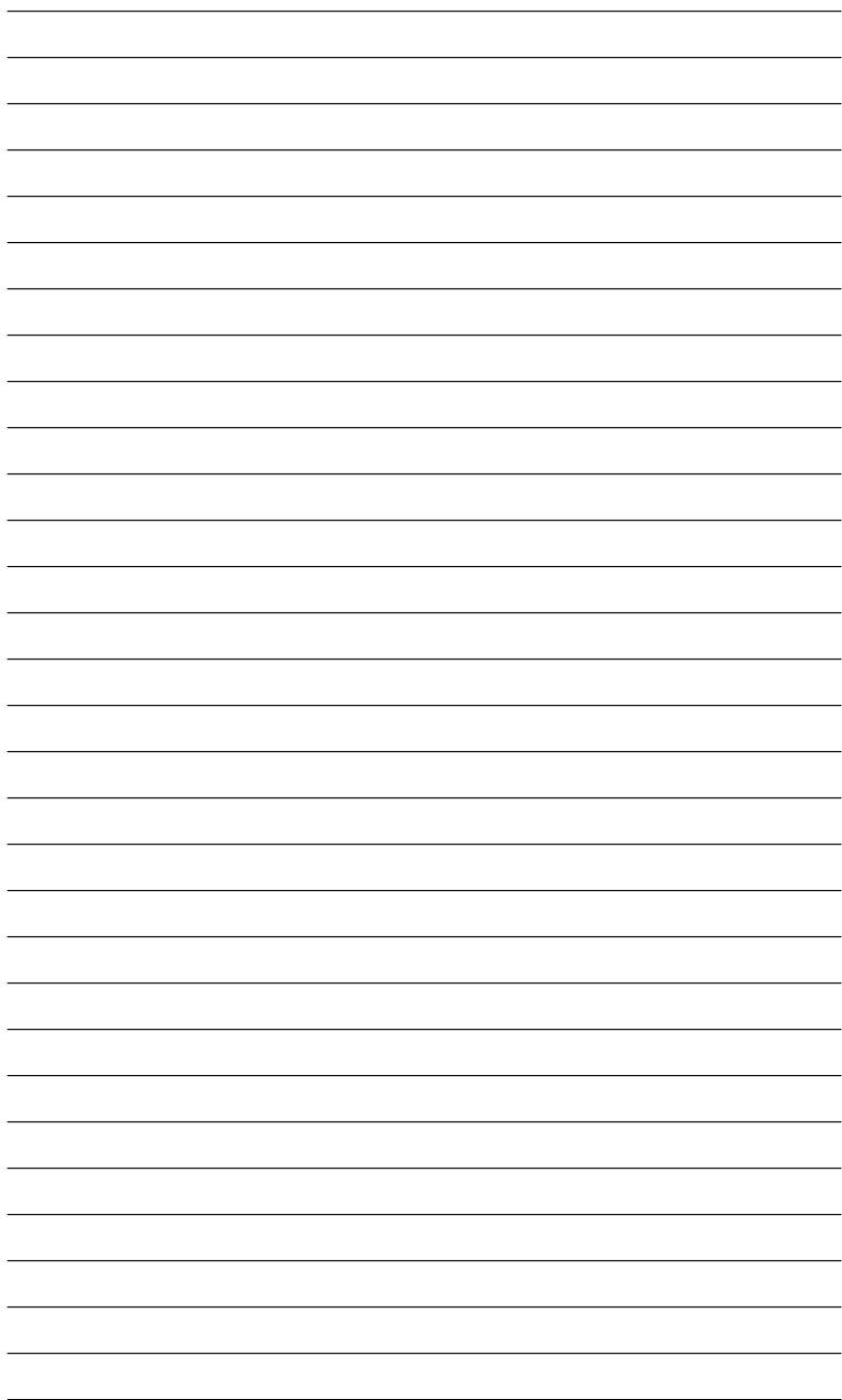
- ☐ Have you surrendered to Jesus relying on His work on the cross to atone for your sins?
