The 40-Day Restore the Table Challenge

THE 40-DAY RESTORE THE TABLE CHALLENGE

With God's help, we will have 5 meaningful mealtimes together per week with those we love for 40 days (total of thirty meals), and we will invite someone outside our circle to join us for three of those meals.

Why Restore the Table? – Conclusions of a 251-page study of the importance of eating together ("Restore the Table" by Ryan Rush):

- "Healthy families eat together. Specifically, they have at least 5 meaningful mealtimes together per week."
- In homes where families have five or more meaningful mealtimes together per week, children are 35% less likely to engage in eating disorders, 24% more likely to eat healthier foods, 12% less likely to be overweight, 34% less likely to smoke, 50% less likely to drink, 50% less likely to be sexually active, 50% less likely to attempt suicide.
- Anne Fishel: "Only 30% of families in America eat together regularly."

Jesus Introduces The Lord's Supper (Matthew 26:17-30)

1. The context of Jesus introducing The Lord's Supper is Jesus' celebrating _____ with His

disciples (vv.17-21a)

- One of Jesus' final acts with His disciples is to eat a meal with them.
- The sequence of events on Jesus' final night with His disciples:
 - They eat the Passover meal together (Matthew 26:19-20)
 - Jesus washes His disciples' feet (John 13:1-20)
 - Jesus identifies Judas as His betrayer (Matthew 26:21-25)
 - Judas leaves (John 13:30)
 - Jesus institutes The Lord's Supper (Matthew 26:26-29)
 - Jesus gives the Upper Room Discourse (John 14-17)
 - Jesus prays in Gethsemane (Matthew 26:36-46)
 - o Jesus is betrayed and arrested (Matthew 26:47-56)
- The Passover ceremony was a commanded remembrance and celebration of God setting the Jewish people free from slavery in Egypt in 1446 BC. The Passover meal consisted of a series of questions and answers and prayers and Scripture readings and eating specific foods that have significant meaning. All of this helped the Jewish people remember how God sent 10 plagues of judgment upon the Egyptians which led the Egyptians to set the Israelites free.

2. Jesus institutes the Lord's Supper during ______ (vv.26-28)

- One of the reasons we know this is because Paul uses the term "cup of blessing" in 1 Corinthians 10:16 when talking about The Lord's Supper.
- Jesus is giving a whole new meaning to the Cup of Blessing and the Cup of Redemption (Cup #3).
- He is announcing a new covenant!
- Luke 22:20 This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood.
- Jeremiah 31:31-34 Behold, the days are coming, declares the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, not like the covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, my covenant that they broke, though I was

their husband, declares the Lord. But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the Lord: I will put My law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be My people. And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor and each his brother, saying "Know the Lord," for they shall all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest, declares the Lord. For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.

- Ezekiel 36:25-27 I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean; I will cleanse you from all your impurities and from all your idols. I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put My Spirit in you and move you to follow My decrees and be careful to keep My laws.
- Major characteristics of the new covenant:
 - (1) Forgiveness of all sin
 - (2) Knowing God personally
 - (3) A new heart
 - (4) Filling by God's Spirit (and thus empowerment to follow God)
- All of these benefits of the new covenant come to us for free as we place our trust in God's Son Jesus Christ (rather than trusting in ourselves). We are bestowed with the cup of blessing as Jesus drinks the cup of plagues in our place.
- Ephesians 2:8-9 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith — and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God not by works, so that no one can boast.
- <u>A Prayer to Receive This New Covenant</u> Jesus, I choose to receive Your new covenant by faith. I receive Your full forgiveness of all my sins! I receive the knowing of You personally! I receive a new heart, a clean heart, a heart that loves God. I receive the infilling of God's Spirit who will empower me to follow Your will.
- <u>Table Talk #2</u> Read Jeremiah 31:31-34 and Ezekiel 36:25-27 at your table. Discuss what it means. Have you received this new covenant? Of all the promises made in this new covenant, which one excites you the most?
- 3. Jesus leaves the Passover ceremony unfinished promising the 4th Cup at His (v.29)
 - I will not drink of the 4th Cup until I return and establish My Kingdom.
 - 1 Corinthians 11:26 For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until He comes.
 - Titus 2:13-14 We wait for the blessed hope the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness and to purify for Himself a people that are His very own, eager to do what is good.
 - John 14:1-3 Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God; trust also in Me. In My Father's house are many rooms; if it were

not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with Me that you also may be where I am.

- Revelation 22:7,12,20 Behold, I am coming soon.
- When we drink of the 4th Cup with Jesus in His Kingdom, we will be free from all of our earthly pain and suffering and grief, and there will be a great celebration of praise to God.
- <u>Table Talk #3</u> What is a pain on earth that you are looking forward to being rid of in heaven? What do you think will be your three favorite things about Heaven?
- <u>Table Talk #4</u> Who is a person whom you really, really want to go to heaven with you? (whom you think doesn't know Jesus yet) If appropriate, have a short time of prayer together praying for these people.

The Story of Another Cup

- The story of Joseph (Genesis 37-50)
- A story about Joseph's cup (Genesis 44-45)

BENJAMIN	THE 10 BROTHERS
Like Jesus	Like Us
"sinless" – Benjamin did not sell his brother Joseph into slavery	"sinful" – The 10 brothers sold their brother Joseph into slavery
Although Benjamin was innocent, the cup caused him to be sentenced to death. (cup of judgment)	The 10 brothers were guilty, but they were spared the cup of judgment. The cup of judgment on the innocent one brought them to discover the true identity of the prince of Egypt leading them to forgiveness and salvation (from famine).
JESUS	ME AND YOU
Although He was without sin, Jesus took the cup of judgment in our place condemning Him to death.	We were guilty but we were spared the cup of judgment. The cup of judgment on the Innocent One (Jesus) brought us to discover the true identity of the Son of God leading to our forgiveness and salvation.
