Four Questions for My Sex Life from Proverbs 5

1. Will I be a _____

son or daughter? (vv.1-2)

- Proverbs is written by a father to his son (1:8) seeking to give him pratical wisdom ("life hacks") about all of life. Proverbs 5, in particular, is a father giving his son wisdom about his sexuality. As with the whole book of Proverbs, this father is calling his son to not be a fool but rather to be wise (vv.1-2,23).
- Proverbs 10:23 Doing wrong is like a joke to a fool, but wisdom is pleasure to a man of understanding.
- Proverbs 13:20 Whoever walks with the wise becomes wise, but the companion of fools will suffer harm.
- <u>Application #1</u> When it comes to my sexuality, am I going to be wise, or am I going to be a fool? In order to be wise, I will...
 - Look to God and His Word as my #1 guide on sexuality
 - □ Keep company with godly and wise people
 - □ Cut off media and people sources in my life that are giving me foolish counsel and influence regarding sexuality.

2. Will I

___ of forbidden doors? (vv.3-14)

- There is a progression toward sin that is clearly outlined in the previous chapter: words (4:24), eyes (4:25), feet (4:26-27).
- The path that leads to sexual sin follows this same progression:
 - Words (5:3-5,7)
 - Eyes/looks (5:3)
 - Feet/path (5:5-6,8)

- According to the Bible, sexual immorality includes pornographic magazines, internet, books, or movies, strip bars, topless bars, adultery, cell phone sex, homosexuality, bisexuality, bestiality, prostitution, friends with benefits, wife swapping (swinging), incest, rape, pedophilia, or engaging in any sexual activity (petting, oral sex, intercourse) with someone you are not married to (Leviticus 18; Exodus 20:14; Matt 5:27-30; 1 Corinth 6:9-11; 1 Thess 4:3-8).
- The father warns his son strongly about the devastating consequences of ignoring his instructions and indulging in sexual sin:
 - Bitterness and deep cut wounds (v.4)
 - o Death (v.5)
 - Loss of honor and valuable time (v.9)
 - Loss of life strength and money (v.10)
 - Great regrets (vv.11-13)
 - Brink of utter ruin (v.14)
- Key command in this section: Steer clear of forbidden doors (v.5)
- <u>Application #2</u> In order to steer clear of forbidden doors, I am going to guard my ears, eyes, and path by...
 - Breaking clean from an immoral relationship. I'm going to tell a trusted friend about my boundary and ask for their accountability.
 - Breaking clean from an emotional relationship that could eventually lead some the wrong path. I'm going to tell a trusted friend about my boundary and ask for their accoutability.
 - Getting Covenant Eyes on all of my electronic devices and asking a trusted friend to hold me accountable: covenanteyes.com
 - Steering clear of specific "forbidden door triggers" for me
 - Other practical tips media, social media
- The story of Joseph and Potiphar's wife (Genesis 39)
- 3. Will I

God's gift God's way? (vv.15-19)

- Let's be clear: God says that sex is very good!!! God created sex! He wants us to enjoy sex in marriage to the max!!!!! (Song of Solomon 5:1c; Genesis 2:24-25; Ecclesiastes 3:12-13; 1 Corinth 7:2-5; Proverbs 5:15-19)
- Two false views of sex that we must overcome:
 - (1) Sex is god (Exodus 20:3)
 - (2) Sex is gross (James 1:17)
- Some people view sex as gross (wrong, yucky, unpleasant, negative, undesirable, loathsome, don't talk about, gross).
- Reasons for a gross view of sex may include: (1) wrong religious teaching; (2) wrong parental teaching; (3) sexual abuse as a child; (4) sexual assault; (5) negative past experiences; (6) damaged emotions from childhood experiences; (7) painful sexual experiences; (8) low hormonal levels or other medical issues; (9) poor self-esteem or body image; (10) fear.

- Instead of viewing sex as god or gross, the Bible invites us to view sex as God's great gift (Proverbs 5:18-19).
- Tim Keller: "Sex is glorious! It is the most ecstatic, breathtaking, daring, scarcely-to-be-imagined look at the glory that is our future."
- <u>Application #3</u> Lord, empower me by Your Spirit to enjoy Your gift of marital sex and to serve my spouse sexually by...
 - Courting my spouse. Going on dates. Pursuing my spouse. Speaking her/his love language frequently.
 - Sharing myself emotionally. Dr. W's daily intimacy exercises:
 - Today, I felt (emotion) when (event)
 - Affirmation of your spouse (quality appreciate)
 - Look into each other's eyes for 60 seconds without talking
 - Pray together
 - Seeking to be attractive to my spouse through healthy eating, exercise, grooming, and the way I dress.
 - □ Initiating love making frequently.
 - □ Responding when my spouse initiates (1 Corinth 7:2-5).
 - Asking my spouse what pleases her/him and seeking to do so.
 - □ Communicating what pleases me and giving my spouse the joy of bringing pleasure to me.
 - Being visually generous to my spouse through what I wear to bed, through lighting (candles), and other means.
 - □ Talking during lovemaking: coaching, expressing pleasure, expressing affection.
 - □ Reading Christian books about healthy and passionate sexuality (Rainey "Rekindling the Romance")
 - Prioritizing and planning lovemaking in the week and in the year.
 - Implementing 7 ideas from "Examples of Servant Lovers"

THIRTY EXAMPLES OF SERVANT LOVERS

- 1. The husband who frequently reaches over and holds the hand of his wife while driving in the car, walking on the sideway, sitting in church, or talking on the couch.
- 2. The wife who gives her husband a hug and a kiss every morning before he leaves the house.
- 3. The husband who frequently gives his wife foot rubs, back rubs, and neck rubs without it leading to sex.
- The husband who practices chivalry with his wife including opening the door, letting her go first, pulling out her chair to be seated, and serving her.
- 5. The husband who frequently gives his wife a kiss on the cheek or on the lips as a non-sexual way to say "I love you."
- 6. The husband who secretly fitted their bed with satin sheets on a special night when they were both anticipating romance.
- 7. The husband who frequently leaves his wife love notes, letters, poems, cards, messages on the bathroom mirror, and other creative written reminders of affection somewhere she will find them.
- 8. The wife who called her husband on his cell phone on his way to work in the morning and said, "Honey, I was thinking of something... well, something a little different I'd really like to try in bed tonight, and I was wondering if you were up for something a little more creative?"
- 9. The husband who frequently initiates going on a "just the two of us" walk together.
- 10. The wife who gave her husband a coupon book with 10 specific, creative redeemable lovemaking coupons.
- 11. The husband who weekly takes his wife out on a date without the kids.

- 12. The wife who gave her husband a document that she created entitled "20 Wavs to Light My Fire" explaining very specifically 20 things that are very sensual to her.
- 13. The husband who took his wife on an old-fashioned picnic.
- 14. The wife who took her husband into the garage after the kids were in bed and initiated a lovemaking date in the back seat of the minivan.
- 15. The husband who occasionally sends or brings his wife flowers.
- 16. The husband who sent a letter to the postmaster of Romance, AR 72136 asking the postmaster to hand stamp the postmark of his enclosed already addressed and stamped love letter to his wife.
- 17. The wife who gave her husband an early Christmas present on Dec. 13 entitled, "The Twelve Nights of Christmas" with one box to open each night – each box containing an item or note that led to a lovemaking encounter for 12 nights in a row.
- 18. The husband who sent a love letter to his wife using FedEx.
- 19. The wife who walked into the den and asked her husband while he was watching the football game, "Do you have any plans for halftime, because if not, I have plans for you to score?" and then walked out of the room.
- 20. The husband who prays with his wife every night and who daily asks his wife, "What can I pray for you today?"
- 21. The husband who reads the Bible to his wife every night.
- 22. The husband who occasionally sets up a "girl's night out" for his wife to go out with her friends.
- 23. The married couple who purposely chooses to go to bed at the same time together every night in the same bed without children or pets in bed.
- 24. The wife who initiated a foosball game where each time **she** scored a goal he had to remove an article of clothing and each time **he** scored a goal she removed an article of clothing.
- 25. The husband who frequently calls his wife in the middle of the day just to see how her day is going and tell her he loves her.
- 26. The husband who fills his wife's car up with gas and gets a car wash and leaves her a note on the dashboard that says. "Thinking of you."
- 27. The wife who spontaneously joined her husband in the shower.
- 28. The husband who appropriately brags on his wife in public.
- 29. The wife who asked her husband to sit down while she got his opinion on a few outfits. She then proceeded to do a fashion show of several outfits that got progressively sexier and ended with lingerie.

- II I live for the _____? (vv.20-23) Sexual sins flow from a short-term, got-to-have-pleasure-now outlook that leads to long-term regrets (vv.20-23, 11-14).
- The Bible exhorts us to make decisions and to live with a longterm, eternal perspective.
- 2 Corinthians 4:18 We look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal.
- Application #4 With God's help, I choose to live for things that count for eternity by...
 - □ Receiving Jesus Christ into my life (John 1:12; Romans 10:9)
 - Investing my life in the Word of God, people's souls, holiness, П and knowing Jesus intimately (2 Peter 3:8-18).
- Sexual sins are not the unforgiveable sin (Matthew 12:31). Confess your sins to Jesus; He will forgive you (1 John 1:9) and make you new (2 Corinthians 5:17).
